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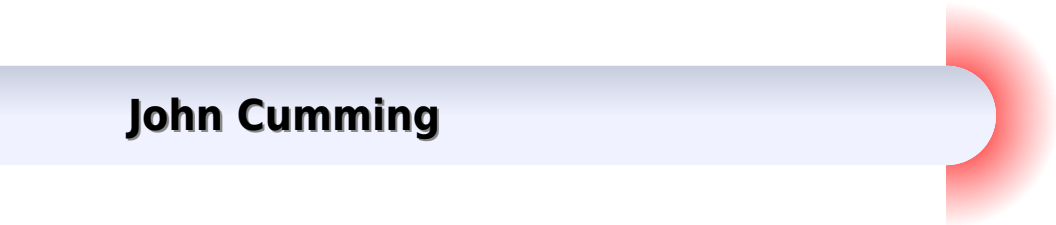

format for the reader to get to know God who we are to Him why we are here and to discover His wonderful pathway leading to eternal life I want to reach those who are led to the Word of God and upon opening up a Bible and reading a few pages become discouraged by its vastness and disconnect of such long ago times The Old Testament truly has a long but remarkable timeline of history and I have endeavored to tie its writings accordingly in a brief walk through these inspired books of the Word of God
