Norse Mythology Charles River Charles River Editors, Andrew Scott, 2018-04-05 Includes pictures Includes medieval accounts of Norse mythology Includes online resources and a bibliography for further reading Much of what is known of the Norse myths comes from the 10th century onwards Until this time and indeed for centuries afterwards Norse culture particularly that of Iceland where the myths were eventually transcribed was an oral culture In fact in all Scandinavian countries well into the 13th century laws were memorized by officials known as Lawspeakers who recited them at the Thing The Thing was the legislative assembly in Scandinavia held for judicial purposes One of the most famous of these Lawspeakers was the Icelander Snorri Sturluson a masterful writer who wrote the Prose Edda in the thirteenth century There are other sources for the Norse myths namely the later Poetic Edda a collection of poems and prose work and other sagas but the Snorri s Prose Edda is the most complete work whose attribution is known to modern scholars The Prose Edda is a collection of Norse Myths split into three sections the Gylfaginning the Deluding of Gylfi the Sk ldskaparm l the Language of Poetry and the H ttatal the Enumeration of Meters The first has a frame story that entails a Swedish King Gylfi disguising himself as an old man Gangleri when he journeys to Asgard to meet the gods When he arrives he meets three men High One Just As High and Third who reveal to him stories of the world and the gods The second section contains a warning for Christians not to believe in the Norse gods specifically the two families the sir and the Vanir but also refutes the notion that they were demons which was a common supposition among some Christians at the time The Prose Edda begins in this line of thought with a euhemeristic prologue which traces the history of the Norse Gods as human heroes of Troy making Thor one of King Priam s sons The Norse Myths also appear to follow a chronological narrative which the historian John Lindow describes as having a Mythical Past Present and Future and it is believed that Snorri a Christian recorded these pagan beliefs to preserve and explain the stylistic poetry of Iceland particularly the popular descriptive devices known as kennings A kenning is made up of a base word and a modifying word that is used to describe a separate object For example Gold had a great many kennings one of which was Sif s Hair If however the memory of Loki cutting off Sif s hair and replacing it with gold were lost then this kenning would make no sense to later readers There are many of these allusions to the myths and it is thanks to them that the myths have survived Thanks to recent Hollywood depictions of the Norse gods they are more popular than ever before For example despite the virtual disappearance of the indigenous Norse religion and mythology several centuries ago modern society still regularly encounters the storm god Thor who continues to be brought back to life in the form of literature and has recently been the protagonist in several blockbuster movies At the same time the scarcity of literature about them leaves room for plenty of debate Modern scholars have to base their theories of Norse gods and the cult practices that are associated with them on fragmentary and untrustworthy sources but despite this for many of the gods there is enough specific information to form a

This little volume is the outcome of several years' experience in telling to classes of children the classic myths, both southern and northern. The insight and interest displayed by the children encourage the authors to hope that other teachers and pupils may enjoy the myths here reproduced. The interest shown at present in the teaching of myths to children seems to call for some such simple volume, giving the Norse myths in suitable form for use with pupils as well as for the children's home reading. There are various collections of the Greek tales, but the books dealing with the Norse myths seem to be more or less cumbered with detail and therefore not adapted to very young readers. The experience of the authors satisfies them that the teaching of myths should begin with those of the North and that the Greek tales should be given later, with comparisons and references to the Norse myths. The stories which were dear to our

own northern forefathers stir our children more deeply and are more congenial to them than those which come down to us from the Greeks This is perfectly reasonable The graphic descriptions in the Norse tales of the hard struggle with rugged nature and the severe climate of the North naturally come home more closely to us than the less rigorous and sturdy conditions of the southern nations Then too the moral tone of the Norse myths is higher purer and more steadfast than that of the Greek tales and is more congenial to our Teutonic point of view Much depends of course upon the teacher's careful study of the myths and insight into their significance They should be presented in such manner as to awaken the interest of the children and lead them to make use of their own imagination The value of the Norse myths has been urged by Carlyle Dasent Anderson and others To me there is in the Norse system something very genuine very great and manlike wrote Carlyle A broad simplicity so very different from the light gracefulness of the old Greek paganism distinguishes this Norse system It is thought the genuine thought of deep rude earnest minds fairly opened to the things about them a face to face and heart to heart inspection of things the first characteristic of all good thought in all times Anderson the author of Norse Mythology wrote In the Norse mythology the centralizing idea is its peculiar feature in it lies its strength and beauty The one myth and the one divinity is inextricably in communion with the other and thus also the idea of unity centralization is a prominent feature and one of the chief characteristics of the Teutonic nations While the Greek mythology foreshadowed the petty states of Greece and southern Europe the Norse mythology foreshadowed the political and social destinies of United Scandinavia United Great Britain and the United States of North America The poetic period of the child's own race should be melted and moulded into poetry touched by a spark of Christian refinement and love and then poured so to speak into his soul The child's mind should feed upon the mythological stories and the primitive folklore of his race While many works have been consulted in the preparation of this volume the authors are especially indebted to the following Thorpe's translation of S mund's Edda The Younger Edda in translations Anderson's Norse Mythology Guerber's Myths of Northern Lands William and Mary Howitt's Literature and Romance of Northern Europe and Mallet's Northern Antiquities
