Choice and happiness

Freedom and autonomy are critical to our well-being, and choice is critical to that. Nonetheless, though modern Americans have more choice than any group of people ever has before, we don't seem to be benefitting from it psychologically.

Problem of adaptation

Because of adaptation (the process of getting used to something and taking it for granted), enthusiasm about positive experiences doesn't sustain itself. This waning of pleasure or enjoyment over time always seems to come as an unpleasant surprise.

Missed opportunities

Part of the downside of abundant choice is that each new option adds to the list of trade-offs, and those have psychological consequences. The necessity of making trade-offs affects the level of satisfaction we experience from the decisions we make.

Everything suffers from comparison

When you are evaluating an experience, you compare it to your expectations. The circumstances of modern life seem to be conspiring to make experiences less satisfying than they could be in part because of the richness against which we are comparing them. Again, an overload of choices contributes to this dissatisfaction.
