The Architecture Definition Document and Architecture Requirements Specification are two significant Deliverables from the ADM Development Phases (A, B, C and D).

They are then used to direct and guide implementation. Here we summarize what they cover, and how they differ.

Overview

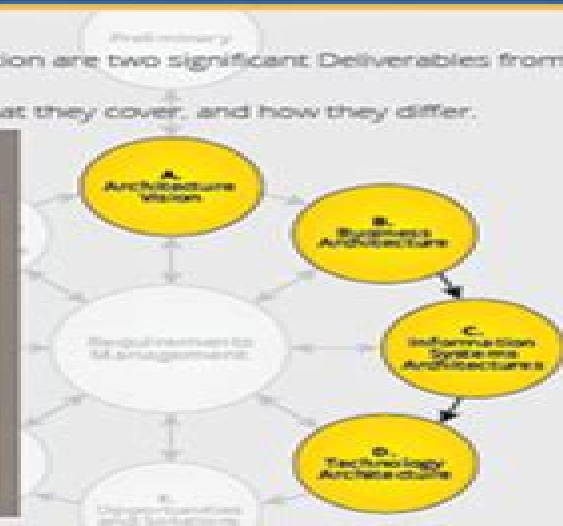
These two deliverables are companion to each other, with complementary objectives.

Architecture Definition Document

A qualitative view of the solution.
Aims to communicate the intent of the architects.
Deliverable container for core architectural artifacts created during a project and related information.
Spans all architecture domains.
Examines all relevant states (baseline, transition, and target).

Architecture Requirements Specification

A quantitative view of the solution.
States measurable criteria that must be met during the implementation of the architecture.
Forms a major component of an implementation contract, or contract for a more detailed Architecture Definition.

Architecture Definition Document

Scope / Goals, objectives, and constraints.
Architecture principles.
Baseline Architecture.
Architecture models (for each state), including Business, Data, Application, and Technology Architecture models.
Rationale and justification for architectural approach.
Mapping to Architecture Repository, including mapping to Architecture Landscape, to reference models, to standards, and Re-use assessment.
Gap analysis and Impact assessment.
Transition Architecture, including Definition of transition states, and Business, Data, Application, & Technology Architecture for each transition state.

Architecture Requirements Specification

Success measures.
Architecture requirements.
Business service contracts and Application service contracts.
Implementation guidelines, specifications and standards.
Interoperability requirements.
IT Service Management requirements.
Constraints and Assumptions.

Transition Architectures show the enterprise at an architecturally significant state between Baseline and Target Architectures.
Transition Architectures can be identified using an Architecture Definition Increments Table.

Each Work Package describes objectives, deliverables, functional requirements, dependencies, business value, and opportunities in relationship to the Architecture Definition Document and Architecture Requirements Specification.
