achieving color cognizance within the group was twofold. It required both the presence of at least a few members who were already color cognizant as well as an environment in which all team members felt relatively safe and behaved in ways that strengthened learning including productively resolving conflict and reflecting on their practice. The Color Bind provides a useful lens for policy makers, researchers, and practitioners pursuing in a wide variety of goals from addressing racial disparities in health and education to creating diverse and inclusive organizations to providing culturally competent services to clients and customers.
