The Bible and Radiocarbon Dating Thomas Levy, Thomas Higham, 2014-12-05 Over the past several years a number of Levantine archaeologists working on the Iron Age ca 1200 586 BCE have begun to employ high precision radiocarbon dating to solve a wide range of chronological historical and social issues The incorporation of high precision radiocarbon dating methods and statistical modelling into the archaeological tool box of the Biblical archaeologist is revolutionizing the field In fact Biblical archaeology is leading the field of world archaeology in how archaeologists must deal with history historical texts and material culture A great deal of debate has been generated by this new research direction in southern Levantine Israel Jordan Palestinian territories southern Lebanon Syria the Sinai archaeology This book takes the pulse of how archaeology science based research methods and the Bible interface at the beginning of the 21st century and brings together a leading team of archaeologists Egyptologists Biblical scholars radiocarbon dating specialists and other researchers who have embraced radiocarbon dating as a significant tool to test hypotheses concerning the historicity of aspects of the Old Testament or Hebrew Bible As this book raises the bar in how archaeologists tackle historical issues as manifest in the interplay between the archaeological record and text its interest will go well beyond the Holy Land

The Formation of the Hebrew Bible David M. Carr, 2011-10-12 In The Formation of the Hebrew Bible David Carr rethinks both the methods and historical orientation points for research into the growth of the Hebrew Bible into its present form Building on his prior work Writing on the Tablet of the Heart Oxford 2005 he explores both the possibilities and limits of reconstruction of pre stages of the Bible The method he advocates is a methodologically modest investigation of those pre stages utilizing criteria and models derived from his survey of documented examples of textual revision in the Ancient Near East The result is a new picture of the formation of the Hebrew Bible with insights on the initial emergence of Hebrew literary textuality the development of the first Hexateuch and the final formation of the Hebrew Bible Where some have advocated dating the bulk of the Hebrew Bible in a single period whether relatively early Neo Assyrian or late Persian or Hellenistic Carr uncovers specific evidence that the Hebrew Bible contains texts dating across Israelite history even the early pre exilic period 10th 9th centuries He traces the impact of Neo Assyrian imperialism on eighth and seventh century Israelite textuality He uses studies of collective trauma to identify marks of the reshaping and collection of traditions in response to the destruction of Jerusalem and Babylonian exile He develops a picture of varied Priestly reshaping of narrative and prophetic traditions in the Second Temple period including the move toward eschatological and apocalyptic themes and genres And he uses manuscript evidence from Qumran and the Septuagint to find clues to the final literary shaping of the proto Masoretic text likely under the Hasmonean monarchy

Emanuel Pfoh, 2016-04-01 Taking advantage of critical methodology for history writing and the use of anthropological insights and ethnographic data from the modern Middle East this study aims at providing new understandings on the emergence of Israel in ancient Palestine and the socio political dynamics at work in the Levant during antiquity The book begins with a discussion of matters of historiography and history writing both in ancient and modern times and an evaluation on the incidence of the modern theological discourse in relation to history and history writing Chapter 2 evaluates the methodology used by biblical scholars for gaining knowledge on ancient Israelite society Pfoh argues that such attempts often apply socio scientific models on biblical narratives without external evidence of the reconstructed past producing a virtual past reality which cannot be confirmed concretely Chapter 3 deals with the archaeological remains usually held as clear evidence of Israelite statehood in the tenth century BCE The main criticism is directed towards archaeological interpretations of the data which are led by the biblical narratives of the books of Judges and Samuel resulting in a harmonic blend of ancient literature and modern anthropological models on state formation Chapter 4 continues with the discussion on how anthropological models should be employed for history writing Socio political concepts such as chiefdom society or state formation should not be imposed on the contents of ancient literary sources i e the Bible but used instead to analyse our primary sources the archaeological and epigraphic records in order to create a socio historical account The final chapter attempts to provide an historical explanation regarding the emergence of Israel in ancient Palestine without relying on the Bible but only on archaeology epigraphy and anthropological insights This Israel is not the biblical one This is the Israel from history the one that the modern historian aims at recovering from the study of ancient epigraphic and archaeological remains The arguments presented challenge the idea that the biblical writers were recording historical events as we understand this practice nowadays and that we can use the biblical records for creating critical histories of Israel in ancient Palestine It also questions the existence of undisputable traces of statehood in the archaeological record from the Iron Age as the biblical

images about a United Monarchy might lead us to believe Thus drawing on ethnographic insights we may gain a better knowledge on how ancient Levantine societies functioned providing us with a context for understanding the emergence of historical Israel as a major highland patronate with a socio political life of almost two centuries It is during the later periods of ancient Palestines history the Persian and the Graeco Roman that we find the proper context into which biblical Israel is created beginning a literary life of more than two millennia One God - One Cult - One Nation Reinhard G.
