1941 thrust towards Moscow and Hitler showed considerable reluctance to agree to the attack believing it best if the Germans suspended operations until spring Halder and his OKW clique persisted however badgering the Fuhrer until Hitler imprudently yielded to their demands The head of the Third Reich apparently succumbed to Halder's and Bock's importuning mostly due to unrestrained ebullience over the southern success He felt that at this stage nothing could go wrong In doing so he forgot the keenly insightful precept of the 17th century samurai general Oda Nobunaga who declared After a victory tighten your helmet straps Far from maintaining his focus however Hitler relaxed and let his guard down His surrender to Halder's impractical plan signaled the beginning of an ominous reversal of Wehrmacht fortunes whose seeds sprouted at the Battle of Moscow
