pig farm of Port Coquitlam in February 2002 the entire 14 acre area was declared a crime scene the largest one in Canadian history Well over 150 investigators and forensics experts were required including 102 anthropology students from across the country called in to sift through the entire farm one shovelful of dirt at a time A woman who is considered by many to be this country's best investigative journalist Cameron has been thinking about the missing women of Vancouver's Downtown Eastside since 1998 when the occasional newspaper story ran about families and friends of some of the 63 missing women agitating for action and being ignored by police and politicians Robert William Willie Pickton has been on her mind since his arrest that February five years ago for the murders of two of the women Mona Wilson and Sereena Abotsway both drug addicted prostitutes from the impoverished neighbourhood where all the missing women had connections Living half time in Vancouver for the last five years Stevie Cameron has come to know many of the people involved in this case from families of the missing women to the lawyers involved on both sides She writes not only with tireless investigative curiosity but also with enormous compassion for the women who are gone and the ones who still struggle to ply their trade on the Downtown Eastside We had no idea in 2002 how massive the investigation would be We had no notion that the police would sift every inch of dirt on the Pickton farm a process that lasted from the spring of 2002 to late 2004 We did not foresee the broad publication ban that would prevent any word printed or broadcast of what was being said in court in case it influenced a potential juror We couldn't know that there would be by 2006 27 charges of first degree murder against Pickton and that the police would continue to investigate him on suspicion of many other deaths And we didn't know that the police and other personnel involved in the case under threat of ruined careers were forbidden to talk to reporters In blissful ignorance all I could do was begin Excerpt from The Pickton File

Assembling Moral Mobilities Nicholas A. Scott, 2020-02-01 In the years since the new mobilities paradigm burst onto the social scientific scene

scholars from various disciplines have analyzed the social cultural and political underpinnings of transport contesting its long dominant understandings as defined by engineering and economics Still the vast majority of mobility studies and even key works that mention the good life and its dependence on the car fail to consider mobilities in connection with moral theories of the common good In *Assembling Moral Mobilities* Nicholas A Scott presents novel ways of understanding how cycling and driving animate urban space place and society and investigates how cycling can learn from the ways in which driving has become invested with moral value By jointly analyzing how driving and cycling reassembled the good city between 1901 and 2017 with a focus on various cities in Canada in Detroit and in Oulu Finland Scott confronts the popular notion that cycling and driving are merely antagonistic systems and challenges social scientific research that elides morality and the common good Instead of pitting bikes against cars *Assembling Moral Mobilities* looks at five moral values based on canonical political philosophies of the common good and argues that both cycling and driving figure into larger more important moral assemblages of mobility finally concluding that the deeper meta lesson that proponents of cycling ought to take from driving is to focus on ecological responsibility equality and home at the expense of neoliberal capitalism Scott offers a fresh perspective of mobilities and the city through a multifaceted investigation of cycling informed by historical lessons of automobility

Greening Post-Industrial Cities Corina McKendry, 2017-09-22 City greening has been heralded for contributing to environmental governance and critiqued for exacerbating displacement and inequality Bringing these two disparate analyses into conversation this book offers a comparative understanding of how tensions between growth environmental protection and social equity are playing out in practice Examining Chicago USA Birmingham UK and Vancouver Canada McKendry argues that city greening efforts were closely connected to processes of post industrial branding in the neoliberal economy While this brought some benefits concerns about the unequal distribution of these benefits and greening s limited environmental impact challenged its legitimacy In response city leaders have moved toward initiatives that strive to better address environmental effectiveness and social equity while still spurring growth Through an analysis that highlights how different varieties of liberal environmentalism are manifested in each case this book illustrates that cities though constrained by inconsistent political will and broader political and economic contexts are making contributions to more effective socially just environmental governance Both critical and hopeful McKendry s work will interest scholars of city greening environmental governance and comparative urban politics
