limiting their influence and participation Although their representation is mainly provided via student self governance organs unions associations and or councils their effectiveness is undermined considerably by the lack of trust and confidence of the student body and the unending manipulation by top university administrators and external political actors Student active involvement in decision making is mainly confined to lower levels such as the school faculty and departmental programme The authors call for a paradigm shift in the involvement of students in the governance of universities in ways that discourage the current culture of tokenism and political correctness that characterizes public and private universities in Kenya
