Democracy, Elections, and Constitutionalism in Africa Charles M. Fombad, Nico Steytler, 2021-03-18 The third wave of democracy that reached African shores at the end of the Cold War brought with it a dramatic decline from 1990 onwards in dictatorships military regimes one party governments and presidents for life Multiparty democracy was at the core of the constitutional revolutions that swept through most of Africa in those watershed years However that wave is either losing momentum or receding or being reversed in its entirety This volume examines democracy and elections in Africa a focus motivated by two concerns First after 30 years it is important to take stock of the state of constitutional democracy on the continent The democratic gains of the 1990s and 2000s seem to be falling by the wayside with the evidence mounting that regimes are concealing authoritarianism under the veneer of elections doing so in an international context where populist regimes are on the rise and free and fair multiparty elections are consequently no longer a given It is becoming a battle to protect and retain constitutional democracy The second reason for this volume s focus on democracy and elections is that multiparty democracy is essential for the proper functioning of the state in addressing the major problems facing Africa internal conflict inequality and lack of development and poor governance and corruption The focus of this volume is thus on how competitive politics or multiparty democracy can be realized and how through competition such politics could lead to better policy and practice outcomes , *The Right to Strike in International Law* Jeffrey Vogt, Janice Bellace, Lance Compa, K D Ewing, John Hendy QC, Klaus Lörcher, Tonia Novitz, 2020-03-19 This monograph was originally developed as a direct response to the claim made by members of the Employers Group at the 2012 International Labour Conference namely that the right to strike is not protected in international law and in particular by ILO Convention 87 on the right to freedom of association The group s apparent aim was to sow sufficient doubt as to the existence of an internationally protected right so that governments might seek to limit or prohibit the right to strike at the national level while still claiming compliance with their international obligations In consequence some governments have seized on the employers arguments to justify new limitations on that right The Right to Strike in International Law not merely refutes this claim but is the only complete and exhaustive analysis on this subject Based on deep legal research it finds that there is simply no credible basis for the claim that the right to strike does not enjoy the protection of international law indeed the authors demonstrate that it has attained the status of customary international law
