

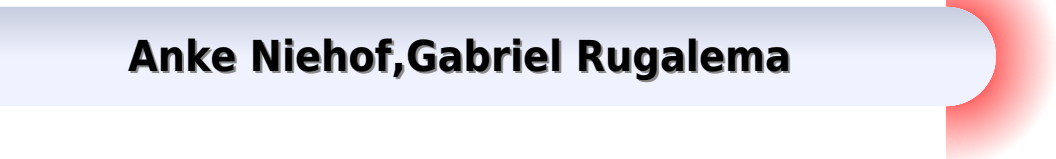

Outcomes of post-2000 Fast Track Land Reform in Zimbabwe Lionel Cliffe, Jocelyn Alexander, Ben Cousins, Rudo Gaidzanwa, 2014-06-11 The struggle over land has been the central issue in Zimbabwe ever since white settlers began to carve out large farms over a century ago Their monopolisation of the better watered half of the land was the focus of the African war of liberation war and was partially modified following Independence in 1980 A dramatic further episode in this history was launched at the start of the last decade with the occupation of many farms by groups of African veterans of the liberation struggle and their supporters which was then institutionalised by legislation to take over most of the large commercial farms for sub division Sustained fieldwork over the intervening years by teams of scholars and experts and by individual researchers is now generating an array of evidence based findings of the outcomes how land was acquired and disposed of how it has been used how far new farmers have carved out new livelihoods and viable new communities the major political and economic problems they and other stakeholders such as former farm workers commercial farmers and the overall rural society now face This book will be an essential starting place for analysts policy makers historians and activists seeking to understand what has happened and to spotlight the key issues for the next decade This book was published as a special issue of the Journal of Peasant Studies

Kamete, 2002 This is a study of the terrain of urban governance using areas of Zimbabwe's biggest city Harare as case studies It presents and discusses sets of perceptions of poverty and the poor which influence policy development and decisionmaking among urban governors Kamete shows the effects of positive as well as negative perceptions of the poor He also problematizes more conventional understandings of poverty and includes into his own conceptual understanding dimensions of deficient access to participation and citizenship He shows that the relationship between power and powerlessness among the poor is much more complex than is sometimes assumed

AIDS and Rural Livelihoods Anke Niehof, Gabriel Rugalema, 2019-01-15 AIDS epidemics continue to threaten the livelihoods of millions of people in sub Saharan Africa Three decades after the disease was first recognized the annual death toll from AIDS exceeds that from wars famine and floods combined Yet despite millions of dollars of aid and research there has previously been little detailed on the ground analysis of the multifaceted impacts on rural people Filling that gap this book brings together recent evidence of AIDS impacts on rural households livelihoods and agricultural practice in sub Saharan Africa There is particular emphasis on the role of women in affected households and on the situation of children The book is unique in presenting micro level information collected by original empirical research in a range of African countries and showing how well grounded conclusions on trends impacts and local responses can be applied to the design of HIV responsive policies and programmes AIDS impacts are more diverse than we previously thought and local responses more varied sometimes innovative sometimes desperate The book represents a major contribution to our understanding of the impacts of AIDS in the epidemic's heartland and how these can be managed at different levels
