

2020 to attempt a critique of the elements of good and bad Anthropocene Though not directly and intimately related to the study of posthumanism and transhumanism yet a discussion of the elements of the Anthropocene will be of immense contemporary relevance to us The next Chapter i e Chapter 5 will attempt to present an explication of the role of machines in the realization of posthuman culture Chapter 6 is primarily concerned with an analysis of Stephen Baxter's novels to see how posthuman culture is constructed around the agency of the autopoietic machines.
