The First Americans

What were the major patterns of Native American life in North America before Europeans arrived?

The Settling of the Americas

- 15,000-60,000 years ago, people came across the Bering Strait
- 11,000 years ago, food supply diminishes as animals (wooly mammoths and bison) become extinct
 - Low food supply = lower population
- 9,000 years ago, agriculture develops making civilizations possible (until then they were nomads following food supply)

Indian Societies of the Americas

- Southern American civilizations were more developed than the Northern Americans
 - Cities, roads, irrigation systems, extensive trade networks, large structures such as pyramid temples
 - **Tenochtitlan**: the capital city of the **Aztec Empire**
 - 250K population
 - Built on marshy islands on western side of Lake Tetzcoco (present day Mexico City)
 - **Inca Kingdom** centered in modern day Peru
 - 12M population
 - Complex system of roads and bridges that extended 2,000 miles along Andes Mountains
 - **North American Indians** lacked technologies of the Europeans
 - metal tools, gunpowder, scientific knowledge for long distance navigation, literacy
 - Europeans used their lack of technologies or "backwardness" as justification for conquest

Mound Builders of The Mississippi River Valley

- Native Americans constructed a large community on a series of giant semicircular mounds on a bluff overlooking the Mississippi River (in present day Louisiana called Poverty Point)
 - Commercial and governmental center whose residents established the trade routes throughout the Mississippi and Ohio River valleys
- "Mound Builders": Ohio River valley residents had traded across half the continent
- **Cahokia**: (Present day St. Louis), City center of the Mississippi River valley residents
 - Mounds up to 100 ft. high
 - 1st developed civilized community in the North
 - From years 1200-1800 it was the largest settled community (NY and Philadelphia become larger in 1800s)

Western Indians

- Hopi and Zuni in present day Arizona
 - Region peaked between years 900-1200
 - Built multiple-family dwellings local canyons in well planned towns, built dams and canals to gather and distribute water, conducted trade with groups as far away as central Mexico
 - Largest dwelling was *Pueblo Bonito* in Chaco Canyo, NM: 5 stories high, 600 rooms
 - Drought caused them to move south and east
 - Established villages and perfected desert farming
- In 16th century, Spanish named them Pueblo Indians because they lived in Pueblos (small villages)

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
