
The first thing you'll do is to create a new project. In Visual Basic, the programs under development are typically called projects or solutions because they contain many individual components, not just one file. A Visual Basic program includes a project file (.vbproj) and a solution file (.sln). A project file contains information specific to a single programming task whereas a solution file contains information about one or more projects.

To create a new project, click Create Project in the Recent Projects Pane.

The New Project dialog box will appear which contains several templates that can be used to create an application. The standard type of windows application is the Windows Forms Application.



Select Windows Forms Application and replace the name of the project to MyFirstVBProgram. You will notice the blank Windows Form in the IDE similar to the figure below. You will use this to build your user interface. Notice that this form appears in a new tab in the IDE.

The Form

The Form is the primary element of your program's interface. It serves as a container that allows other objects (called controls) to be inserted.
