Design Development Gabriel Patrocínio, José Mauro Nunes, 2019-10-10. The subject of Design Policies is slowly growing to be broadly discussed, although most of the time from within a design practitioners and design enthusiasts' bubble. Lawmakers and government executives are still distant, frequently without a real knowledge of design and its potential. Governments and designers as well seem to be contented by design promotion actions or programmes which are frequently wrongly accepted as a design policy.
