Testis Mass

Initial Consultation

- Testicular ultrasound
- Serum AFP, hCG, LDH (tumor markers)

Inguinal Orchiectomy

Alternatives

- Testis-sparing surgery (TSS) if bilateral GCT or functionally solitary testis and mass < 2 cm

Confirmed Diagnosis of Germ Cell Tumor (GCT)

Staging

- CT of abdomen/pelvis with contrast
- Chest XR or CT
- Serum tumor markers post orchiectomy

Alternatives

- Chest CT if evidence of nodal metastatic disease or rising tumor markers
- MRI if CT is contraindicated

Special considerations

- Repeat imaging if equivocal findings AND normal AFP, hCG
- Patients with elevated AFP, hCG preorchiectomy should be followed to establish nadir levels.
