Also known as the Texas Education Agency, is a 15 member elected board, overseen by the Commissioner of Education, who is appointed by the Governor. Currently the state has 10 Republican members and 5 Democrat and is highly conservative, as is reflective of the state. They're elected to four-year terms, and every ten years they're required to reevaluate and make any changes they deem necessary to Texas textbooks.
