Visual Perception Part 1 Susana Martinez-Conde, S. Macknik, Maria M. Martinez, Jose-Manuel Alonso, Peter U. Literary Censorship in Francisco Franco's Spain and Getulio Vargas' Brazil, 1936-1945 Gabriela de Lima Grecco, 2020-04-14 This book presents two systems of censorship and literary promotion revealing how literature can be molded to support authoritarian regimes The issue is complex in that at a descriptive level the strategies and methods new states use to control communication through the written word can be judged by how and when formal decrees were issued and how publishing media whether in the form of publishing companies or at the individual level engaged with political overseers But equally literature was a means of resistance against an authoritarian regime not only for writers but for readers as well From the point of view of historical memory and intellectual history stories of people without history and the production of their texts through the literary underground can be constructed from subsequent testimony from books sold in secret to the writings of women in jail to books that were written

but never published or distributed in any way and to myriad compelling circumstances resulting from living under fascist authority A parallel study on two fascist movements provides a unique viewpoint at literary social and political levels Comparative analysis of literary censorship literary reward allows an understanding of the balance between dictatorship official policy and what literary acts were deemed acceptable The regime need to control its population is revealed in the ways that a particular type of literature was encouraged in the engagement of propaganda promotion and in the setting up of institutions to gain international acceptance of the regime The work is an important contribution to the history of twentieth century authoritarianism and the development fascist ideas

Southern Hemisphere Palaeobiogeography of Triassic-Jurassic Marine Bivalves Susana E. Damborenea, Javier Echevarría, Sonia Ros-Franch, 2012-09-26

Palaeobiogeography is a complex subject which processes information provided by both Biology and Earth Sciences It is conceptually and philosophically equivalent to neobiogeography Nevertheless its methods are somewhat different since it is limited by the incompleteness of the fossil record On the other hand it has direct access to the time dimension a key ingredient of organic evolution Mesozoic benthonic mollusks and especially bivalves have a great potential for palaeobiogeographical analysis due to their commonly good preservation abundance diversity and high dispersion potential at the larval stage From a merely descriptive point of view the analysis of their distribution shows latitudinal gradients and distributional patterns both at regional and global scales which are the basis for the recognition of biochoremas or palaeobiogeographical units of different ranks Moving forward towards a causal palaeobiogeography these organisms also provide interesting insight into particular biogeographical questions such as bipolarity and its origin The evolution in time of the recognized biochoremas can be discussed in relation to palaeoclimas and extinction events Finally some of the results obtained from the analysis of the distribution of past bivalve biotas were even used to propose and discuss the development of marine corridors and argue about the distribution of continents in the past

Verb Classes and Aspect Elisa Barraón López, José Luis Cifuentes Honrubia, Susana Rodríguez Rosique, 2015-11-15 This volume offers a variety of perspectives on two of the main topics situated at the crossroads between lexical semantics and syntax namely a aspect and its correspondence with syntactic structure and b the delimitation of syntactic structures from verb classes Almost from Aristotle's Metaphysics it has been assumed that verbs invoke a mental image about the way in which eventualities are distributed over time When it comes to determining time schemata the lexical class to which the verb belongs represents a first step Speaking about verb classes does not exclusively mean a semantic similarity rather verb classes exhibit a bundle of common features and thus show a set of recursive behavior patterns Beyond the meaning of the verb both semantic and syntactic factors together with pragmatic ones play a decisive role when establishing the aspectual classification of an eventuality The contributions collected in this book approach the aforementioned lines either analyzing the relationships between aspect and syntactic structure or traversing the path from a verb class to its syntactic manifestation Some of them

stress diachronic filiations while others include processes of word formation in the debate some of them focus on certain classes such as movement verbs or psychological verbs while others examine specific constructions A number of chapters also discuss relevant theoretical issues concerning the analysis of aspect In sum the kaleidoscopic view provided by this book allows the reader to delve deeper into one of the most controversial as well as exciting topics within current linguistics
