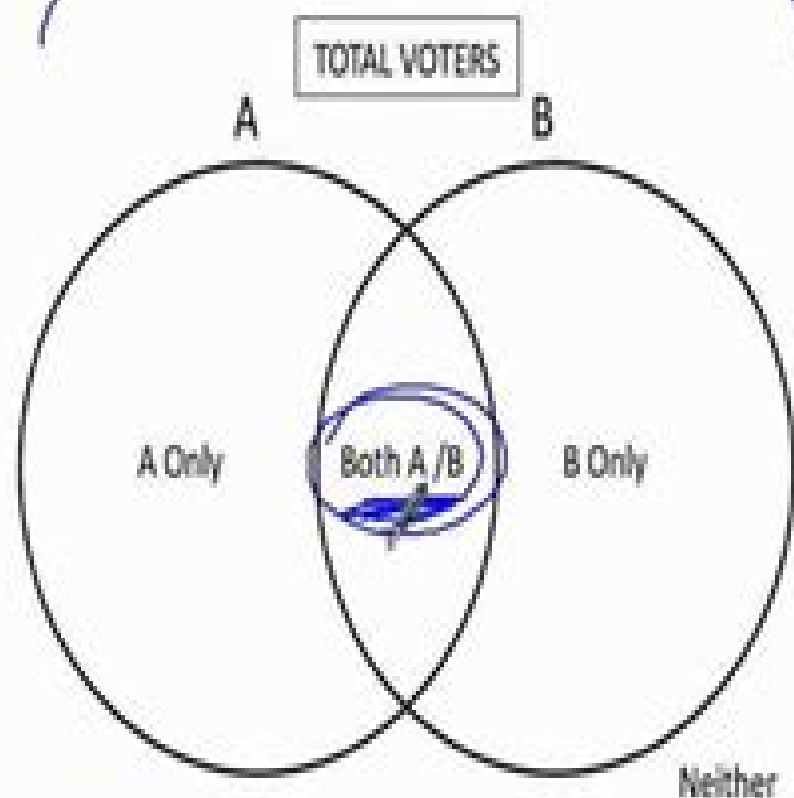


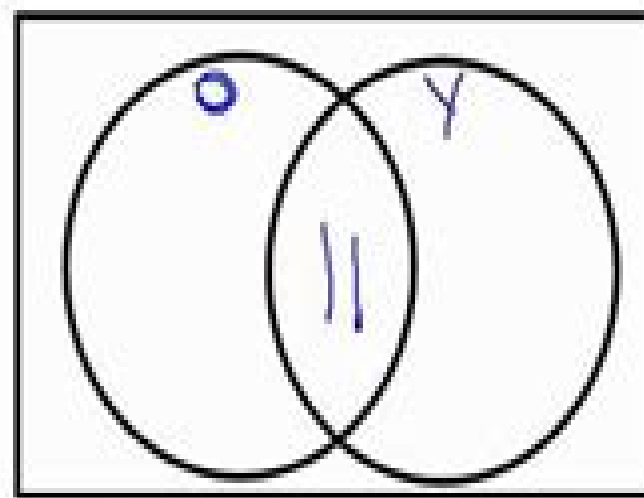
VENN DIAGRAM PROBLEMS
