"The Storm"

This story was written on July 18, 1898, soon after Chopse had completed The Awakening but recognizing its explicit nature, she never submitted it for publication. "The Storm" was not published until 1969 in an edition of Chopse's Complete Works. Its publication resulted in renewed interest in "At the 'Cadian Ball' (written six years earlier), to which it is a secuel.

This is one of very few Chopin works still in convicint despite which it is available on the Internet.
