



Investigation of a Tuberculosis Outbreak in the Washington State Prison System

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Background

During 2014–2020, six TB cases were identified in Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) prison facilities.



Facility A



Facility B

During investigation (2021), four TB cases and 27 latent TB infections (LTBI) were identified among Facility A residents. No other cases were identified.

Three TB cases were also identified at Facility B during December 2021–January 2022.

In January 2022, WACD and Washington State Department of Health (DOH) requested DOC assistance in facilitating ongoing outbreak investigations efforts.

Investigation

A multi-agency investigation led by WACD and DOH is ongoing.

Investigation Objectives



Find & track TB disease



Identify & test contacts



Treat LTBI



Determine chains of transmission

Casey Prison with TB disease were identified through facility-based screening and resident notification. Cases were characterized through chart review and interviews with case and public health staff. Latent TB patients were screened per CDC guidelines, more extensive (2-month) infection control measures were taken when positive screening results were shown.

Casey (2021) data patients were used to identify residents and staff who had spent a 2 days or more isolated in prison and TB during their infectious periods. Contacts were invited using letters and text to infectious patients' prison email.

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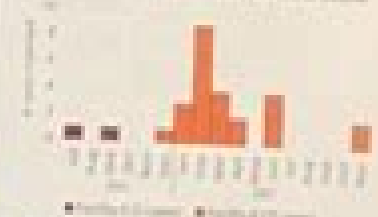

During 2021–2023, a multi-agency investigation identified 27 TB cases among residents and 250 latent TB infections among contacts in the Washington State prison system.

Findings

During 2021–November 2023, 27 TB cases among residents in prison were identified, most from Facility A (20 cases).



27 individuals had previously TB disease. 4 had prior history TB and were not screened before.

Among groups comprising individual top 20 screened contacts from patients with culture positive TB were screened. 47 residents were screened for latent TB disease.

The median infection period for 27 patients was 10 months (range 1–24 months).

100% resident and staff contacts from all facilities have been identified. Among 1,000 residents tested who did not have a known history of TB, 250 (25%) had LTBI.

Public Health Response

WACD and DOH implemented a multi-pronged response:

- Implemented TB prevention & control measures
- Identified & tested LTBI in prison inmates
- Facilitated screening with active TB and latent TB testing
- Provided TB education for residents, families, & staff

Conclusions
