

These frame tale interludes frequently include transcriptions of Italian folk songs The interactions among tales in a day or across days as Boccaccio spins variations and reversals of previous material forms a whole and not just a collection of stories The basic plots of the stories including mocking the lust and greed of the clergy tensions in Italian society between the new wealthy commercial class and noble families the perils and adventures of traveling merchants
