Hi-Temp Wash Option

When HI-TEMP WASH option is selected, the heating element in the bottom of the tub will raise the main wash and final/rinse water temperature to approximately 140°F. Wash action will continue but timer will not advance until this water temperature has been reached. The hotter water provided by this option helps activate dishwasher detergent to clean food grease and soil from dishes. HI-TEMP WASH can be used with any cycle except RINSE & HOLD. The WATER HEATING light will glow until the water temperature reaches 140°F. To turn off HI-TEMP WASH option, push the RESET OPTIONS button.

Lo-Temp Dry Option

LO-TEMP DRY saves electricity. The heating element stays off during the drying portion of the cycle. Additional drying time may be required, with the door open, to completely air dry dishes. Some water droplets may remain on door and in areas where dishes touch dishwasher basket or rack.

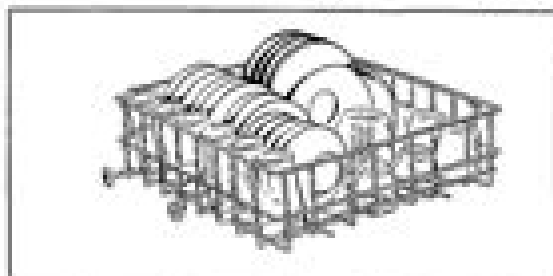
To turn LO-TEMP DRY option off and select a heated drying cycle, push the RESET OPTIONS button. If the LO-TEMP DRY option is not selected, a heated drying cycle is automatically provided. LO-TEMP DRY must be selected with the RINSE & HOLD cycle. The drying option may be changed at any time during the cycle and affects only the drying period.

Top Rack

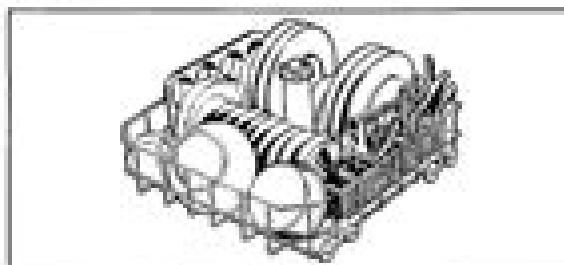
Load glasses, cups, bowls, "dishwasher safe" plasticware, and miscellaneous items on the top rack between prongs.



Bottom Rack

Load large plates, platters, bowls, casserole dishes, silverware, and pots and pans on the bottom rack.

Place items on racks with soiled surfaces facing the center of the rack. Be sure large items do not block the detergent dispenser preventing it from opening during the wash cycle.



Silverware Basket



Load knives and fork with handles up. Be sure items do not protrude through the holes in the basket and stop the rotation of the spray arm.

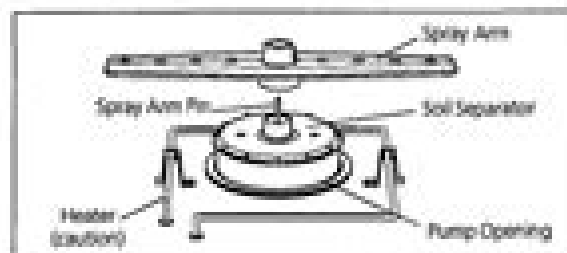
Cleaning the Pump and Spray Arm

Your dishwasher will flush away all normal food soils. However, objects (bones, fruit pits, etc.) may collect in openings and should be removed to avoid clogging the drain.

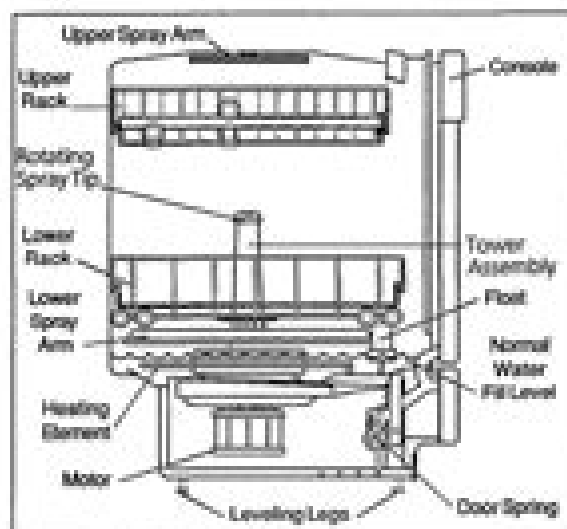
Caution: To prevent injury, allow dishwasher to cool before cleaning.

Caution: Be careful when cleaning around the pump area. There may be glass fragments from broken glass items.

1. Remove nut and lift out spray arm. Clean out spray holes.
2. Clean in and around pump openings.
3. Replace spray arm on spray arm pin. Replace and tighten nut. Spray arm should rotate freely.



Important Parts of Your Dishwasher



It is Normal:

- To have short pauses during operation of dishwasher.
- For a small amount of water to remain in bottom of tub.
- To hear water entering dishwasher as it fills.
- To hear water being pumped out of dishwasher as it drains.
- To hear timer clicking as dishwasher cycles advance.
