



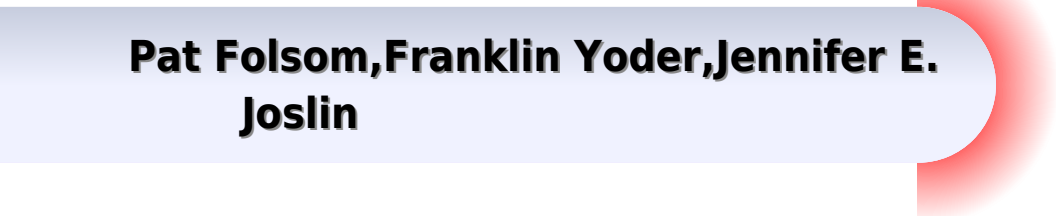

debut for NRL club Wests in 2003 at just 18 and has been with the club ever since He was a member of the Wests premiership winning team in 2005 and despite a string of injuries including major shoulder surgery twice his star has continued to rise His performances for the Kiwis in recent years have left critics on both sides of the Tasman breathless In this book Marshall will not just talk about his great career but also his childhood in New Zealand he was raised without his biological father his move to Australia and his storybook entry into the game at the highest level
