Distance : $d = \sqrt{(x_1 - x_2)^2 + (y_1 - y_2)^2}$

Midpoint : $\left(\frac{x_1 + x_2}{2}, \frac{y_1 + y_2}{2} \right)$

Circle : $(x - h)^2 + (y - k)^2 = r^2$

Center : (h, k) Radius : r

Complete the Square

- Use the quadratic formula to find the one unique solution

$$x = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a} \rightarrow x = \frac{-b}{2a}$$

Ex: $x^2 + y^2 - 6x + 8y + 3 = 0$

$$(x^2 - 6x + 9) + (y^2 + 8y + 16) = -3 + 9 + 16$$

$$h = \frac{-b}{2a} = \frac{6}{2(1)} = 3 \quad k = \frac{-b}{2a} = \frac{-8}{2(1)} = -4$$

$$(x - 3)^2 + (y + 4)^2 = 22$$

$$C = (3, -4) \quad r = \sqrt{22}$$

FunctionsDomain : all values of x that are allowed to be plugged into $f(x)$.Range : all values of y that come out of $f(x)$.Changes to the inside of functions can alter the domain.Changes to the outside of functions can alter the range.Rules for finding domain for a given $f(x)$

1. No zeros in the denominator!
2. No negatives under an even root ($\sqrt{x}$, $\sqrt[4]{x}$, $\sqrt[6]{x}$, etc.) $\rightarrow x \geq 0$
3. Only positives inside logs. $x > 0$

Lines

Slope : $m = \frac{\Delta y}{\Delta x} = \frac{y_1 - y_2}{x_1 - x_2}$

Point slope Formula : $y - y_1 = m(x - x_1)$

Slope - intercept Form : $y = mx + b$

$$b = y\text{-intercept } (0, b)$$

- parallel lines $m_1 = m_2$
- perpendicular $m_1 = -\frac{1}{m_2}$

Intercepts :

Polynomials :

$$a_n x^n + a_{n-1} x^{n-1} + \dots + a_1 x^1 + a_0 x^0$$

- exponents can only be positive integers (whole numbers)
- each power should appear only once!

$$x^3 - 3x + 2x - 6 \leftarrow \text{No!}$$

$$x^3 - x - 6 \leftarrow \text{Yes!}$$
