OF WESTERN ANTI-ISLAMIC ANTAGONISM: JUDAISM, CHRISTIANITY AND THE SECULAR ÖMER KEMAL ŞAHİN,2022-09-01 This research seeks to examine the root causes of Western anti Islamic antagonism in the three main realms of the West i e Judaism Christianity and the secular To achieve this goal it first focuses on the Jewish and Christian scriptures and perceptions in chronological order Their respective manifestations in history are introduced encompassing the Medieval period age of Islamic conquests Middle Ages Early Modern Period and Contemporary Period Since the literature hardly conceptualises Jewish or Christian anti Islamism as such relevant knowledge was extracted from the present literature and put into a coherent narrative The findings indicate that Jewish and Christian scriptures particularly the passages about Abraham Sarah Hagar Isaac and Ishmael and contents concerning eschatology make anti Islamic interpretations possible Jewish anti Islamic antagonism is observed to primarily stem from the ethno centric self perception and eschatological

of Asia is characterized by what amounts to a self inflicted humiliation in misguided efforts to slow the advance of a rising Islamist tide Such appeasement surrenders core aspects of sovereignty turning non Muslim populations into second and third class citizens in their own countries Disturbing warning signs first emerged in Europe but were either not noticed or denied They extended to the periphery of the Muslim world but their development in Western countries were unnoticed or denied until they hit also the peripheral areas of the Muslim world Canada and Australia and to some extent the countries of Asia fell into a syndrome of denial which persisted until they were forced to listen often at a price in human lives and carnage In Europe the core of the Muslim presence developed in countries like Britain France and Germany which lacked law enforcement against terrorists because the executive and judiciary emphasized human rights and apparent safety over defensive measures to protect their citizens and way of life Both the United States and Great Britain needed a traumatic jolt before they moved to act In the United States it would be the watershed event of September 11 2001 in London the July 7 2005 bombings And there were events in other countries in Spain the March 2004 Madrid train bombings in France the violent riots of 2005 in Amsterdam the van Gogh murder in Asia the Bali horror and finally in Scandinavia the Cartoon Affair These jolts shattered the tranquility of populations who had believed in peaceful coexistence with Muslim immigrants and in the feasibility of their integration into national societies This study fills a large void in the examination of the consequences of new migrations of Muslim populations into advanced and modern societies throughout the world

The New American Imperialism Vassilis Fouskas, Bülent Gökay, 2005-10-30 With the terrorist attacks of September 11 2001 the United States long war on communism was replaced by a perpetual war on terror The authors posit that this neo imperialistic phase is but the latest development in a line of thought and action established after World War II But they say 2005 is not 1945 Today they argue the United States uses its power to deplete the resources of the developing world and to compel the rest of the world to remain dependent on American management of the global economy Contending that this situation is ultimately untenable they assert that the United States is entering a period of deep crisis The best thing for American neo imperialists to do to avert their worst nightmare a strategic and economic alliance among Europe Russia China and OPEC would be to arrange for the orderly withdrawal of American power before it is too late for the human and environmental security of the world When the Soviet Union collapsed in 1991 the Cold War slowly gave way to a new world order in which the United States was left as the lone superpower But the organizing principle that would characterize the early 21st century was as yet unclear until the terrorist attacks of September 11 2001 Now it is clear that the long war on Communism has been replaced by a perpetual war on terror Regardless of how long American troops remain in Iraq and irrespective of further military actions George W Bush will continue to be a wartime president whose foreign policy is dominated by the Pentagon And yet the authors argue this neo imperialistic phase with its emphasis on Eurasian oil supplies is but the latest development in a line of thinking and acting in the world that was established by such men as Dean Acheson and Paul Nitze after World War II

But 2005 is not 1945 and the United States despite Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld and Vice President Dick Cheney's assertions is not liberating Iraq and Afghanistan in the same way that U.S. forces liberated Germany and Japan; it is not reconstructing Iraq or the former Yugoslavia as it did when it rebuilt war-torn western Europe with the Marshall Plan. The United States with its thinly stretched military and deficit-laden economy does not possess the means to do so today. Instead, the authors maintain, the United States is simply depleting the developing world's natural resources, compelling the rest of the developed world to remain dependent on American management of the global economy. This situation is ultimately untenable, the authors argue, and as a result the United States is entering a period of deep crisis.
