Jackie Robinson

Since the early 1900s, there was an unwritten rule in American sports that races didn't mix. On April 15, 1947, thanks to a forward-thinking general manager looking to end racial segregation in baseball, Jackie Robinson walked onto first base for the Dodgers and became the first African-American to play Major League Baseball. He also led the league in stolen bases and earned the honor of Rookie of the Year.

Born in January 1919, Robinson was one of five children raised by a single mother. He grew up with a love of sports and participated in football, basketball, baseball, track and tennis in both high school and college. At UCLA, he was part of one of the first integrated college football teams. While at UCLA, he met Rachel Isum, a nursing student and his future wife.

Jackie Robinson is best known for his role in breaking down racial barriers in baseball, but his activism extended beyond that experience. In 1936, Robinson was involved in a disputing racist disciplinary actions against a friend. In 1944, Robinson refused to move to the back of a military bus and was arrested and court-martialed.

In 1945, Robinson was drafted by the Kansas City Monarchs, a Negro League team. His success sparked an interest in pursuing a career in Major League Baseball. There had been rumors of some teams looking to sign black players. Robinson met with Branch Rickey, General manager of the Brooklyn Dodgers. Rickey signed Robinson under the agreement that he would "have the other check." He told Robinson he only wanted him if "he had guts enough not to fight back" when faced with racism. Robinson agreed and was paid \$6000 month, equal to a little over \$8,700 a month today.

Throughout his career, Robinson faced racism head-on. As other teams signed more African-American players, some racial pressure diminished but never went away entirely. When he became Hall of Fame eligible in 1962, Robinson wanted to be recognized for his athleticism rather than his cultural impact on the game. But through his career, he continued to take many steps that were firsts for people of color. He was the first black player inducted into the Hall of Fame, the first to appear on a sports analysis for ABC television, and later the first to serve as Vice President for an American Corporation (Check Full O' Nuts, a coffee brand).

Following Jackie Robinson's death on October 24, 1972, his wife Rachel founded The Jackie Robinson Foundation. The non-profit organization provides scholarships to minority youth for higher education and aims to preserve the legacy of Jackie Robinson. Robinson and his wife had three children. His daughter Sharon has published several children's books dedicated to his memory.
