grammaticalized forms of each variety are described on the basis of their employment in discourse The underlying general function of the Tibetan verbal system is thus shown to be that of RELATIVE TENSE Secondary aspectual functions are described for restricted contexts A special focus on the pragmatic or metaphorical use of present tense constructions in Tibetan leads to a typology of narrative conventions The last part also offers some suggestions for the reconstruction of the Proto Tibetan verb system *The Development of Past Tense Morphology in L2 Spanish* M.
