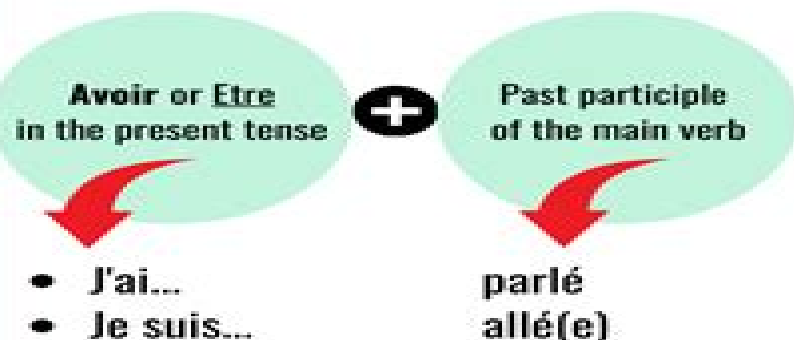


Passé composé *vs.* Imparfait

- Expresses what happened a specific number of times



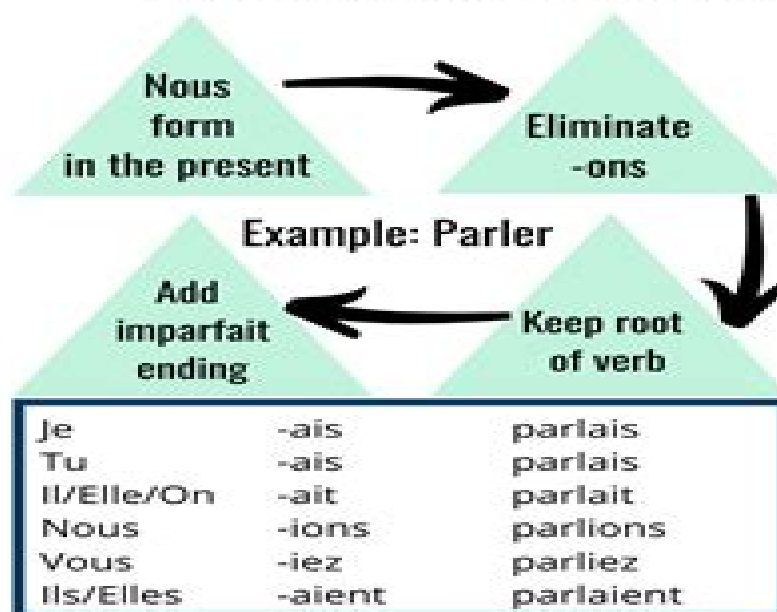
