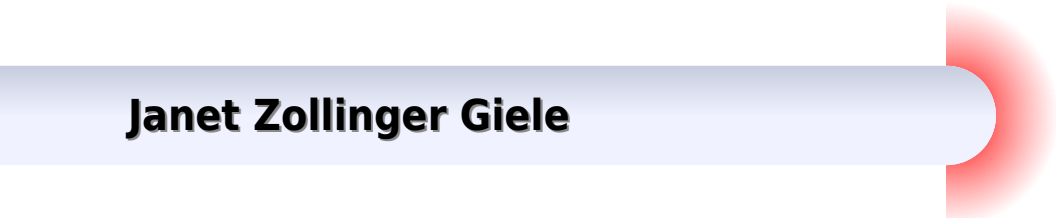
IV. THE RISE OF AMERICAN BUSINESS, INDUSTRY AND LABOR (1865 - 1920)
