

US History Benchmark #4

Civil Rights Movement

- **Brown v. Board of Education** - Governors in southern states disregarded the ruling which led the federal government to intervene
- **Dr. King** - supported integrating all facilities and institutions in the United States to end injustice and opposed using physical violence to achieve the goals of the civil rights movement
- **The Interstate Commerce Commission**- outlawed segregation in all facilities involved in interstate commerce.
- **Voting During the Civil Rights** - People such as President Lyndon B. Johnson pushed for federal government approved legislation that **banned literacy tests and poll taxes** expanding suffrage.
- **NAACP** - activists were able to use the court system to have discriminatory laws declared unconstitutional. This was successful in Brown v. Board of Education as school segregation was declared unconstitutional (and this idea could also be used in other scenarios such as bussing)
- **Montgomery Bus Boycott**- activists did not ride city busses in Montgomery and were successful as segregation on busses was declared unconstitutional
- **March on Washington**- Was a peaceful protest to encourage Congress to pass Civil Rights legislation. This was eventually successful with the passage of the Civil Rights Act and Voting Rights Act.
- **Freedom Rides**- activists participated in freedom rides in which they rode on busses and attempted to use facilities as an integrated group which was successful in having the interstate commerce commission intervene to enforce segregation on buses.
- **The Voting Rights Act of 1965**- was successful because there was increase in African Americans who were able to vote in 1965
- **Malcolm X**- believed that African Americans should use arms if necessary to defend themselves
- **How did legislation of the 1960s impact American society?** by promoting equal opportunity and reducing poverty

Americas' Perception of Government

- **Cause** the American people to question the government -
 - The American people were told that a U.S. victory was near in Vietnam but this event revealed the conflict was far from over (Tet Offensive)
 - The American people were informed by the media that members of the U.S. military had killed innocent Vietnamese civilians.
 - The government deceived the American people about their involvement in Vietnam. (Bombing of Cambodia)
 - Richard Nixon became the first president in U.S. history to resign from office - Watergate Scandal
 - Reagan decided to negotiate with Iran - It's clear from the Board's report, however, that I let my personal concern for the hostages spill over into the geopolitical strategy of reaching out to Iran.
 - The media revealed that the information the government provided to the public was not always accurate.
 - Presidents of the United States and/or members of their administrations became involved in illegal activities.
 - As Americans began to doubt their government, increasing numbers of citizens participated in protests of government actions.
 - Troops killed college students in the Kent State Massacre
- **Effects** of American People Question to Government
 - In response to declining confidence in the government, Congress passed legislation to limit the power of the executive branch.
