This saw real estate loose value to the point that the real estate valuations got lower than the mortgage loans.

Another reason for the crisis was the low interest rates in mortgage and subprime mortgage in particular. The action by the federal bank to reduce short term rates in order to correct the 2000 recession was also a factor. The low rates that were reduced
