Suitcases and Backpacks Chava Kohavi Pines, 2014-09-30 *Suitcases and Backpacks* is a testimony of intricate detail that describes a young girl's survival in ghettos and concentration camps between 1942 and 1945. Readers follow her heartbreaking journey from Vienna to the Theresienstadt Ghetto to Auschwitz to a labor camp near Breslau followed by the alienation she feels upon returning to Vienna, her subsequent journey to Prague and finally the realization of her dream to immigrate to Palestine. Chava Kohavi Pines was born Eva Hirsch in 1927 in Vienna, Austria, to a middle class Jewish family. Since immigrating to Palestine in 1946, the author has resided in Kibbutz Dorot in the northern Negev where she worked as a teacher and counselor for years. These families coped with changing regulations that disrupted family life pitted relatives against each other and raised profound questions about religious, ethnic, and national identity. Bukey finds that although intermarried couples lived in a state of fear and anxiety, many managed to mitigate delay or even escape Nazi sanctions. Drawing on extensive archival research, his study reveals how hundreds of them pursued ingenious strategies to preserve their assets, to improve their racial status, and above all, to safeguard the position of their children. It also analyzes cases of intermarried partners who chose divorce as well as persons involved in illicit liaisons with non-Jews. Jews and Intermarriage in Nazi Austria concludes that although most of Vienna's intermarried Jews survived the Holocaust, several hundred Jewish partners were deported to their deaths, and children of such couples were frequently subjected to Gestapo harassment.
