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The Integration of the UCLA School of Law, 1966–1978 Miguel Espinoza, 2017-12-01 In 1966 a group of UCLA law school professors sparked the era of affirmative action by creating one of the earliest and most expansive race conscious admissions programs in higher education The Legal Education Opportunity Program LEOP served to integrate the legal profession by admitting large cohorts of minority students under non traditional standards and sending them into the world as emissaries of integration upon graduation Together these students bent the arc of educational equality and the LEOP served as a model for similar programs around the country Drawing upon rich historical archives and interviews with dozens of students and professors who helped integrate UCLA this book argues that such programs should be reinstituted and with haste because affirmative action worked

Defending the nuclear family and extolling family values have long been central features of politics in capitalist societies in spite of radical left challenges from social counter-cultural and gay rights movements.
