Staghorn Sumac (Rhus typhina)



Physical Description: An open habit and hairy stems give this sumac the appearance of deer antiers, hence the name. Dioecious, separate male and female plants.

Leaves: Compound leaves are alternate in arrangement. Large leaves consist of 11-25 linear shaped leaflets that are finely toothed. Top sides of leaflets are dark green and hairy, undersides are smooth and white. One of the last to leaf out in spring. Fall colors are brilliant yellows, orange and scarlet.





Flowers: Separate male and female plants. Flowers appear in June and July as large (up to 12"), dense panicles of yellow green flowers. There are 100-700 flowers per panicle. Inflorescences arise from twigs. Each flower has five spreading petals, 5 fused sepals, 5 stamens and one central pistil.

Fruit: Large, upright clusters of densely fuzzy, bright red fruits. Appear in late summer, August to September, and can persist through mid-winter. Fruits seem to rise above the branches, sticking out on top of shrub. Each fruit is a dry fleshed drupe containing a single seed. Drupes are %" across. Shrub takes 3-4 years to produce fruits.



Anacardiacea Family



Habitat: Salt tolerant. Found along dry forest edges, meadows, disturbed areas, lake shores, sandy shores and growing on rocky slopes. Highly adaptable to various sit conditions. Prefers dry to moist but well drained soils in full sun. Will not tolerate wet niches.

Propagation: Woody suckering shrub that spreads by running rhizomes. Late Winter/ Early Spring coppicing or low mowing encourages suckering response. Softwood outtings can be taken in dormancy. Seeds can be sown in fall to winter over coarse soils.





Additional information: Fruits can be enjoyed as an infused beverage. Seeds are edible but hard to chew. High in vitamin C. Sumac fruit flesh is a popular middle eastern cooking spice. Flowers provide pollen for short tongued bees, flies and wasps. Carpenter bees burrow into the stems for shelter. Larval host for many butterflies and moths. Fruits provide winter food for songbirds and small mammals.

Dormant Season Identification:

U shaped Leaf scar partially to completely surrounds each bud. Buds are alternate, sessile, have no scales (naked) and are softly heiry. Twigs are reddish brown and covered in fine rust colored hairs. Fruit persist into winter.
