- **Academically deserving and financially needy students** have the opportunity to apply for a loan from NSFAS, part of which can be converted to a bursary, subject to academic results.
 - Loans do not always cover tuition fees and other study costs in full. The amount of the loan is determined, among other things, by the family's financial need and the student's cost of study.
