Catalog of Books, 1996 **Colorado's Volunteer Infantry in the Philippine Wars, 1898-1899** Geoffrey Hunt, 2006 The experiences of the First Colorado Infantry in America's quest for empire at the end of the nineteenth century Empires Without Imperialism Jeanne Morefield, 2014-03-12 The end of the Cold War ushered in a moment of nearly pure American dominance on the world stage yet that era now seems ages ago Since 9/11 many informed commentators have focused on the relative decline of American power in the global system While some have welcomed this as a salutary development outspoken proponents of American power particularly neoconservatives have lamented this turn of events As Jeanne Morefield argues in *Empires Without Imperialism* the defenders of a liberal international order steered by the US have both invoked nostalgia for a golden liberal past and succumbed to amnesia forgetting the decidedly illiberal trajectory of US continental and global expansion Yet as she shows the US is not the first liberal hegemon to experience a wave of misguided nostalgia for a bygone liberal order England had a remarkably similar experience in the early part of the twentieth century The empires of the US and the United Kingdom were different in character the UK's was territorially based while the US relied more on pure economic power yet both nations mouthed the rhetoric of free markets and political liberty And elites in both painted pictures of the past in which first England and then the US advanced the cause of economic and political liberty throughout the world Morefield contends that at the times of their decline elites in both nations utilized the attributes of an imagined past to essentialize the nature of the liberal state Working from that framework they bemoaned the possibility of liberalism's decline and suggested a return to a true liberal order as a solution to current woes By treating liberalism as fixed through time however they actively forgot their illiberal pasts as colonizers and economic imperialists According to Morefield these nostalgic narratives generate a cynical politics in the passive where the liberal state gets to have it both ways it is both compelled to act imperially to save the world from illiberalism and yet is never responsible for the outcome of its own illiberal actions in the world or at home By comparing the practice and memory of liberalism in early nineteenth century England and the contemporary United States *Empires Without Imperialism* addresses a major gap in the

continued to plot against King Louis Philippe and his July Monarchy In early 1832 after failing to launch a coup in Southern France Legitimists plotted an unsuccessful uprising in the Vendée a region in Western France that had supported the royalist cause during the French Revolution The Duchesse de Berry led the rebellion in the hopes of placing her son the Bourbon heir on the French throne The revolt marked the last attempt by the Bourbons to retake the throne by force and helped solidify the end of the Bourbon dynasty During the cholera outbreak which also spread throughout France in 1832 lower income areas suffered higher losses to the disease for they were more likely to have contaminated water supplies The lower classes spread rumors that the outbreak was an elitist plot to subdue the masses and the epidemic exacerbated class tensions Meanwhile conditions in France continued to be characterized by violence during the early 1830s as Louis Philippe attempted to establish his regime's authority The most significant of these uprisings was the republican dominated June Revolution of 1832 Victor Hugo and other contemporaries perceived the barricades of June as natural extensions of the cholera epidemic or the political continuation of a biological crisis The sad fate of the uprising however prompted republicans to regroup and develop new strategies for success As a whole then 1832 helped solidify the end of the Bourbon monarchy and class identities and was a crucial moment in the reorganization and growing solidification of French republicanism that paved the way for the Revolution of 1848 This edited collection examines these three pivotal events in French history in 1832 a royal Legitimist uprising led by the Duchesse de Berry the cholera epidemic and the June Revolution featured in the climax of Hugo's novel *Les Misérables* within the context of the legacy of the French Revolution While the events of 1832 are significant they have been relatively ignored because scholars have been distracted by the Revolutions of 1830 and 1848 This collection is the first piece of scholarship to examine these three events in an interconnected pattern to better examine France as it transitioned from a monarchy to a republic As a result this collection will be of value to both historians and academics studying diverse subfields within French and European studies
