

BUDGET FRAMEWORK

- A budget deficit of 3.9 per cent of GDP is expected for 2014/15, narrowing to 2.5 per cent in 2015/16.
- Debt costs as a percentage of GDP is expected to stabilise at 40.7 per cent in 2015/16.
- The main budget non-interest expenditure ceiling has been reduced by R25 billion over the next two years.
- Increases in personal income tax rates and the general fuel levy are set to add R6.6 billion to gross tax revenue in 2015/16.
- Any additional personal headcount for 2015/16 and 2016/17 will be paid for from existing allocations.
- Real growth, minus interest spending will average 2.1 per cent over the next three years and will be more closely aligned to long-term average real GDP growth than 2013/14.
- Capital remains the fastest-growing form of non-interest spending over the medium term, with compensation and goods and services growing slower.

SPENDING PROGRAMMES

- Over the next three years, government will spend:
 - An additional 29 percent per year, increasing expenditure from R124 billion in 2014/15 to R160 billion in 2017/18.
 - At least 60 percent of non-interest expenditure for capital services and different priority.
 - R647 billion on basic education, including R36.7 billion on school infrastructure.
 - R6.4 billion on local development and social infrastructure, including R10.3 billion on municipal infrastructure.
 - R600 billion on health, with R164 billion on the HIV and AIDS conditional grant.
 - R688 billion social protection.
 - R197 billion on post-school education and training.
 - R16 billion on providing free markets over 5 million learners.
