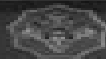

BACKGROUND

THE MILITARY SKILLS DEVELOPMENT SYSTEM (MSDS)

The South African Army, through its Military Skills Development System (MSDS), is offering young South African citizens an opportunity to serve in uniform on a two-year contract. The Military Skills Development System is a two-year voluntary service system with the long term goal of enhancing the SA National Defence Force's deployment capability.

Successful MSDS candidates will be appointed in a specific mustering and will be called up to a Training Unit, where members will complete their Basic Military Training, specific mustering and functional training in the first year and be utilized or deployed internally or externally in the second year of the MSDS.

Requirements:

- No dual citizenship: Be a South African citizen only
- Grade 12 Applicants must be between the ages of 18 – 22 years
- Graduates and/or other Tertiary Qualification up to the age of 25 years
- Successfully completed Grade 12 with (Average of 50% or level 4) (Mathematics and Science will be advantageous)
- Admission Point Score (APS) of 17 incl Life Orientation (LO)
- Leadership potential
- Not to be area bound
- Have no criminal record or pending cases
- Comply with medical fitness requirements for the appointment (Minimum height Females 148cm, Males 155cm and Minimum weight Females 48kg, Males 52kg (Within average height/weight ratio).

N.B. During the selections, the applicants will be subjected to **Psychometric and Medical Evaluations; Verification of criminal records; Vetting and Verification of qualifications.**

experience and battle hardiness adapting to the conditions of the campaigns and the demands of the tasks South Africa's campaigns were complex and divergent starting with the invasion of neighbouring German South West Africa to neutralise enemy radio stations and so aid the security of the South Atlantic Suddenly suspended following the outbreak of the Afrikaner Rebellion the campaign recommenced in January 1915 Following its conclusion an infantry brigade raised for Western Front service was diverted to Egypt before facing near annihilation at Delville Wood Simultaneously a large South African force fighting alongside British African and Indian forces overcame German resistance in East Africa whilst a brigade of field artillery and later the Cape Corps served in Egypt and Palestine Moreover approximately 6 500 South Africans served in the British Army Royal Flying Corps Royal Air Force and in the Royal Navy Although lionised during the war by a British public hungry for heroes there is a different side to Botha and Smuts Shunned by Afrikaner nationalists at the time they have remained divisive figures Responsible for the enactment of the Land Act of 1913 which shaped South Africa's socio economic and political landscape Botha's statues in Cape Town Durban and Pretoria were vandalised on a number of occasions between 2015 and 2022 and there were recent calls for Smuts's statues to be removed Behind Botha's charming attractive facade and Smuts's stoic machine were two very human imperfect and quite probably inconsiderate men Together they provide a wonderful lens through which to examine the potent forces of the early twentieth century world and the country they hoped to forge Myopic compatriots had constrained their plans but it was the outbreak of war in 1914 that offered the most significant opportunities and brought the most adverse challenges They fought insurmountable odds and achieved great victories at home and abroad but also made startling errors and ultimately in classical fashion risked being crushed by the weight of the world they tried to create

A Military History of Modern South Africa Ian van der Waag, 2018-03-14

The story of a century of conflict and change from the Second Boer War to the anti apartheid movement and the many battles in between Twentieth century South Africa saw continuous often rapid and fundamental socioeconomic and political change The century started with a brief but total war Less than ten years later Britain brought the conquered Boer republics and the Cape and Natal colonies together into the Union of South Africa The Union Defence Force later the SADF was deployed during most of the major wars of the century as well as a number of internal and regional struggles the two world wars Korea uprising and rebellion on the part of Afrikaner and black nationalists and industrial unrest The century ended as it started with another war This was a flash point of the Cold War which embraced more than just the subcontinent and lasted a long thirty years The outcome included the final withdrawal of foreign troops from southern Africa the withdrawal of South African forces from Angola and Namibia and the transfer of political power away from a white elite to a broad based democracy This book is the first study of the South African armed forces as an institution and of the complex roles that these forces played in the wars rebellions uprisings and protests of the period It deals in the first instance with the evolution of South African defense policy the development of the armed forces and the people who served in and commanded them It also

places the narrative within the broader national past to produce a fascinating study of a century in which South Africa was uniquely embroiled in three total wars African Armed Forces Journal ,2005-02 *Southern Africa in Crisis* ,1988-01-01

A Question of Loyalty Alon Peled,1998 States that use military conscription and whose ethnic minorities have relatives in hostile countries face a Trojan horse dilemma the state demands military service but mistrusts the loyalty of subjugated community members Some armies brutalize ethnic recruits others simply reject them Alon Peled compares the experiences of Malay Muslim soldiers in Singapore Arabs in Israel and blacks in South Africa Drawing on his interviews with senior officers and policymakers he examines the histories of these armies and their levels of ethnic integration He also suggests how minority soldiers can be gradually recruited integrated and promoted Ethnic soldiers can only succeed Peled argues when officers formulate manpower policy on the basis of combat needs rather than political concerns Peled highlights the behind the scenes roles played by officers and ethnic leaders He advocates new policies for change recommending that the leaders of ethnically torn countries such as the republics of the former Soviet Union and states in central Africa allow professional officers to introduce soldiers from mistrusted ethnic groups through a process of phased integration **Report of His**

sons of chiefs and headmen While other men his age were joining Umkhonto weSizwe Holomisa enrolled in the Transkeian Defence Force and rose rapidly through the ranks As head of the Transkeian Defence Force Holomisa led successive coups against the homeland regimes and then became the head of its military government He turned the Transkei into a liberated space giving shelter to ANC and PAC activists and declared his intention of holding a referendum on the reincorporation of the Transkei into South Africa These actions brought him immense popularity and the military dictator became a liberation hero for many South Africans When the unbanned ANC held its first election for its national executive in 1994 Holomisa who had by now joined the party received the most votes beating long time veterans and party stalwarts He and Mandela developed a close relationship and Holomisa served in Mandela's cabinet as deputy minister for environmental affairs and tourism As this biography reveals the relationship with both Mandela and the ANC broke down after Holomisa testified before the Truth and Reconciliation Commission among other issues that Stella Sigcau and her cabinet colleagues had accepted a bribe from Sol Kerzner After being expelled from the ANC Holomisa formed his own party the United Democratic Movement with Roelf Meyer As leader of the UDM Holomisa has played a prominent role in building coalitions among opposition parties and in leading important challenges to the dominant party This biography written in collaboration with Holomisa presents an engaging and revealing account of a man who has made his mark as a game changer in South African politics
