conservative voices of the time Indeed the leap to California governor in 1966 seemed almost preordained in which Reagan became a bellwether for a nation in the throes of a generational shift Reagan's 1980 presidential election augured a shift that continues into this century Boot writes not as a partisan but as a historian seeking to set the story straight He explains how Reagan was an ideologue but also a supreme pragmatist who signed pro abortion and gun control bills as governor cut deals with Democrats in both Sacramento and Washington and befriended Mikhail Gorbachev to end the Cold War A master communicator Reagan revived America's spirits after the traumas of Vietnam and Watergate But Boot also shows how Reagan was armored in obliviousness He traces Reagan's opposition to civil rights over forty years reveals how he neglected the exploding AIDS epidemic and details how America experienced a level of income inequality not seen since the Gilded Age With its revelatory insights Reagan His Life and Legend is no apologia depicting a man with a good versus evil worldview derived from his moralistic upbringing and Hollywood westerns Providing fresh examinations of trickle down economics the Cold War's end the Iran Contra affair as well as a nuanced portrait of Reagan's family this definitive biography is as compelling a presidential biography as any in recent decades

One Shining Moment Gilbert Jonas, 2000 During the darkest hours of World War II a Scarsdale NY high school student experienced a vision of the possibilities of a peaceful postwar world From this mystical moment came the most powerful American student movement of the postwar decade the Student Federalists who pressed their elders and their contemporaries to consider the establishment of a world government based on the same principles which guided our nation s Founding Fathers more than a century and a
