Unit 1: The Civil War and Reconstruction

Pre-Civil War 1820-1860

1. **Missouri Compromise:** Authored by Henry Clay in 1820, Missouri was admitted to the Union as a slave state, Maine entered the Union as a free state, and slavery was banned from existing above the 36-degree 30 parallel.
2. **Abolitionist Movement:** A movement that emerged in the 1830's to abolish the institution of slavery. The American Anti-Slavery Society was founded by William Lloyd Garrison in 1833. Renowned slaves such as Frederick Douglass and Sojourner Truth actively advocated the immediate end of slavery.
3. **Uncle Tom's Cabin:** Harriet Beecher Stowe's 1852 novel *Uncle Tom's Cabin; or, Life among the Lowly* was a response to the Fugitive Slave Law which was the most controversial part of the compromise of 1850. This fictional story that criticized slavery exaggerated story which stirred up passions.
4. **Kansas-Nebraska Act (1854):** This document was created by Senator Stephen Douglas and it encouraged the KS and NE territories to be organized using popular sovereignty, which is significant because it nullified the Missouri Compromise.
5. **Bleeding Kansas 1856:** The nickname given to the Kansas territory when Civil War erupted in response to the Kansas-Nebraska Act between Pro-Slavery forces in Leavenworth and Anti-Slavery forces in Topeka, Kansas in.
6. **Dred Scott Decision (1857):** It stated the Scott was not a citizen and had no authority to sue in court, being taken to free territories in the North did not guarantee him his citizenship. Congress has no power to prohibit the spread of slavery into the territories, and the Missouri Compromise is null and void.
7. **The Mexican American War 1846-1848:** The acquisition of new territory (present day CA, NM, AZ, NV, UT) led to dispute over how this new territory would be organized as either slave or free states. This issue further divided America and hastened the coming of the Civil War.
8. **The Compromise of 1850:** Temporarily settled disputes among the states by admitting CA as a free state, NM and AZ to be decided using popular sovereignty, no more slave trading in DC, no Congress official intervention in the interstate slave trade, and the creation of a stronger fugitive slave law.
