thing that is true to itself.
For example, "She's the realest
person I know. She always tells it
like it is."

KEEPING IT HONEST

"Realest" can also mean being honest and truthful, even if it's not what someone wants to hear. For example, "I appreciate you being the realest with me and telling me the truth about my performance."



STAVING TRUE TO YOURSELF

Another meaning of "realest" is staying true to yourself and not pretending to be someone you're not. For example, "I respect him for being the realest and not trying to fit in with the crowd."
