of dress and housing to the way they planted crops and expressed themselves spiritually In the face of the white reformers contradictory assumptions that Indians could assimilate into the American mainstream and that they lacked the mental and moral wherewithal to transform the Ioways became adept at accepting necessary changes while refusing religious and cultural conversion Nonetheless as Olson's work reveals agents and missionaries managed to plant seeds of colonialism that would make the Ioways susceptible to greater government influence later on in particular by reducing their self sufficiency and undermining their traditional structure of leadership Ioway Life offers a complex and nuanced picture of the Ioways efforts to retain their tribal identity within the constrictive boundaries of the Great Nemaha Agency Drawing on diaries newspapers and correspondence from the agency s files and Presbyterian archives Olson offers a compelling case study in U S colonialism and Indigenous resistance Smithson's Gamble Tom D.
