The Red Man's Bones Benita Eisler, 2013-07-15 The first biography in over sixty years of a great American artist whose paintings are more famous than the man who made them George Catlin has been called the first artist of the West as none before him lived among and painted the Native American tribes of the Northern Plains After a false start as a painter of miniatures Catlin found his calling to fix the image of a vanishing race before their extermination his word by a government greedy for their lands In the first six years of the 1830s he created over six hundred portraits unforgettable likenesses of individual chiefs warriors braves squaws and children belonging to more than thirty tribes living along the upper Missouri River Political forces thwarted Catlin s ambition to sell what he called his Indian Gallery as a national collection and in 1840 the artist began three decades of self imposed exile abroad For a time his exhibitions and writings made him the most celebrated American expatriate in London and Paris He was toasted by Queen Victoria and breakfasted with King Louis Philippe who created a special gallery in the Louvre to show his pictures But when he started to tour live troupes of Ojibbewa and Iowa Catlin and his fortunes declined He changed from artist to showman and from advocate to exploiter of his native performers Tragedy and loss engulfed both This brilliant and humane portrait brings to life George Catlin and his Indian subjects for our own time An American original he still personifies the artist as a figure of controversy torn by conflicting demands of art and success *The Red Man's Bones: George Catlin, Artist and Showman* Benita Eisler, 2013-07-22

Worthen, 2021-02-09 Volume I Quilts and textiles Ceramics Silver Weaponry Furniture Vernacular architecture Native American art volume II Photography Fine art Ioway Life Greg Olson, 2016-05-10 In 1837 the Ioways an Indigenous people who had called most of present day Iowa and Missouri home were suddenly bound by the Treaty of 1836 with the U S federal government to restrict themselves to a two hundred square mile parcel of land west of the Missouri River Forcibly removed to the newly created Great Nemaha Agency the Ioway men women and children numbering nearly a thousand were promised that through hard work and discipline they could enter mainstream American society All that was required was that they give up everything that made them Ioway In Ioway Life Greg Olson provides the first detailed account of how the tribe met this challenge during the first two decades of the agency s existence Within the Great Nemaha Agency s boundaries the Ioways lived alongside the U S Indian agent other government employees and Presbyterian missionaries These outside forces sought to manipulate every aspect of the Ioways daily life from their manner

of dress and housing to the way they planted crops and expressed themselves spiritually In the face of the white reformers contradictory assumptions that Indians could assimilate into the American mainstream and that they lacked the mental and moral wherewithal to transform the Ioways became adept at accepting necessary changes while refusing religious and cultural conversion Nonetheless as Olson s work reveals agents and missionaries managed to plant seeds of colonialism that would make the Ioways susceptible to greater government influence later on in particular by reducing their self sufficiency and undermining their traditional structure of leadership Ioway Life offers a complex and nuanced picture of the Ioways efforts to retain their tribal identity within the constrictive boundaries of the Great Nemaha Agency Drawing on diaries newspapers and correspondence from the agency s files and Presbyterian archives Olson offers a compelling case study in U S colonialism and Indigenous resistance
