University Governance in Kenya Mulinge, Munyae M.,Arasa, Josephine N.,2017-05-05 This book examines the concept of the democratization of governance in universities in Kenya with particular emphasis on students involvement in governance processes and decision making Data were collected from members of the student community utilizing a structured self administered questionnaire and from purposively selected key informants and focus group discussants drawn from Kenyatta University representing the public sector and the United States International University representing the private sector The guiding argument for the study was that shared governance one of the principles of good governance is critical in enabling the universities to deliver their visions and the missions effectively The results revealed that while in principle Kenyan universities have embraced democratic governance in which all stakeholders including students have a role to play in practice they continue to violate the core principles of good governance particularly shared governance Specifically students who are major stakeholders in university education are largely excluded from significant structures of governance thereby limiting their influence and participation Although their representation is mainly provided via student self governance organs unions associations and or councils their effectiveness is undermined considerably by the lack of trust and confidence of the student body and the unending manipulation by top university administrators and external political actors Student active involvement in decision making is mainly confined to lower levels such as the school faculty and departmental programme The authors call for a paradigm shift in the involvement of students in the governance of universities in ways that discourage the current culture of tokenism and political correctness that characterizes public and private universities in Kenya

degradation which is occurring in almost all terrestrial biomes and agro ecologies in both low and high income countries and is stretching to about 30% of the total global land area About three billion people reside in these degraded lands However the impact of land degradation is especially severe on livelihoods of the poor who heavily depend on natural resources The annual global cost of land degradation due to land use and cover change LUCC and lower cropland and rangeland productivity is estimated to be about 300 billion USD Sub Saharan Africa SSA accounts for the largest share 22% of the total global cost of land degradation Only about 38% of the cost of land degradation due to LUCC which accounts for 78% of the US 300 billion loss is borne by land users and the remaining share 62% is borne by consumers of ecosystem services off the farm The results in this volume indicate that reversing land degradation trends makes both economic sense and has multiple social and environmental benefits On average one US dollar investment into restoration of degraded land returns five US dollars The findings of the country case studies call for increased investments into the rehabilitation and restoration of degraded lands including through such institutional and policy measures as strengthening community participation for sustainable land management enhancing government effectiveness and rule of law improving access to markets and rural services and securing land tenure The assessment in this volume has been conducted at a time when there is an elevated interest in private land investments and when global efforts to achieve sustainable development objectives have intensified In this regard the results of this volume can contribute significantly to the ongoing policy debate and efforts to design strategies for achieving sustainable development goals and related efforts to address land degradation and halt biodiversity loss
