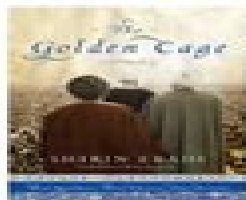

The Golden Cage Shirin Ebadi, 2011-04-30 Shirin Ebadi the first Muslim woman to receive the Nobel Peace Prize 2003 and the only Iranian to receive a Nobel Prize in any field releases a new memoir in April 2011 entitled The Golden Cage Three Brothers Three Choices One Destiny The book is a fascinating contemporary autobiographical story of how Iran came to be the nation it is today The timeliness of her writing is all the more important with daily breaking news of democracy arising in the region As she says of her new publication History is best described through life stories that are told in simple ways by appealing to what human beings hold in common the love of life and country She is a remarkable woman because of her keen intellect but even more so because of her inbred commitment to and understanding of egalitarianism It is honest to interpret this to mean she is a fierce advocate for women's and children's rights In addition to focusing on bringing democracy to Iran she is a visionary in having foreseen what we are now witnessing in the Middle East and foreseeing the same to be inevitable throughout the world for all dictatorships Dr Ebadi attributes this in part to the spread of technology which allows those imprisoned by governments to see how the free world lives Naturally the oppressed choose free will She also believes the innate human spirit to be a driving force behind the inevitability of democracies Of central importance in Dr Ebadi's message about Iran and Islam is that she is a moderate She believes Islam and democracy are compatible Dr Ebadi loves peace and abhors violence In between those two ends lays a middle ground in which she deftly works to persuade world leaders and the world population to better understand her homeland A place where she describes the people as a simmering kettle bubbling to the top is her voice and those of others calling for Iran's democratization Clearly this has made her an enemy of the current Iranian regime She was out of the country when those ruling Iran further attacked in June 2009 compelling her to begin a life in exile She would face certain arrest and imprisonment were she to return home For now she believes it is best to remain living in exile and to continue speaking out around the world advocating peacefully for all people to be free from oppression Her new book The Golden Cage and companion public speaking itinerary are crucial parts of her plan

Beck, 2023-02-24 A Journey through Story to Poiva a N u An Ancient Tamil Kingdom This remarkable epic length legend presents a rich and well rounded view of local South Asian folk history masterfully interwoven with many social themes and multiple layers of religious tradition The text provides a lively read and can be enjoyed by students of all backgrounds and levels This richly decorated oral telling combines numerous poetic songs with direct conversations and detailed narrative passages The descriptive segments help to advance a broader story trajectory leading the reader towards a long foretold yet still surprising conclusion In 1965 a highly respected troubadour duo C R mac mi of Eruca amp ayam and his nephew Pa a ic mi sang this magnificent legend in front of a live South Indian village audience It took them eighteen nights to complete this tale Weeks later the senior performer R mac mi patiently dictated this same story to a local assistant who was working for the translator at the time The text was meticulously written down by hand phrase by phrase over many days Both bards wanted to preserve a story they knew in their hearts was truly unique and sacred Each gave the present collector permission to share the words of this tale They wanted the whole world to learn about a great legend they had themselves spent years learning This story is about the potential for social renewal and those two singers believed it could better the lives of all who listened to it Fifty five years later following in the footsteps of these two men their enthusiasm has now born fruit in a book they had both hoped for but could never have written themselves

The Mirror and the Mind Katja Guenther, 2024-11-26 How the classic mirror test served as a portal for scientists to explore questions of self awareness Since the late eighteenth century scientists have placed subjects humans infants animals and robots in front of mirrors in order to look for signs of self recognition Mirrors served as the possible means for answering the question What makes us human In The Mirror and the Mind Katja Guenther traces the history of the mirror self recognition test exploring how researchers from a range of disciplines psychoanalysis psychiatry developmental and animal psychology cybernetics anthropology and neuroscience came to read the peculiar behaviors elicited by mirrors Investigating the ways mirrors could lead to both identification and misidentification Guenther looks at how such experiments ultimately failed to determine human specificity The mirror test was thrust into the limelight when Charles Darwin challenged the idea that language sets humans apart Thereafter the mirror previously a recurrent if marginal scientific tool became dominant in attempts to demarcate humans from other animals But because researchers could not rely on language to determine what their nonspeaking subjects were experiencing they had to come up with significant innovations including notation strategies testing protocols and the linking of scientific theories across disciplines
