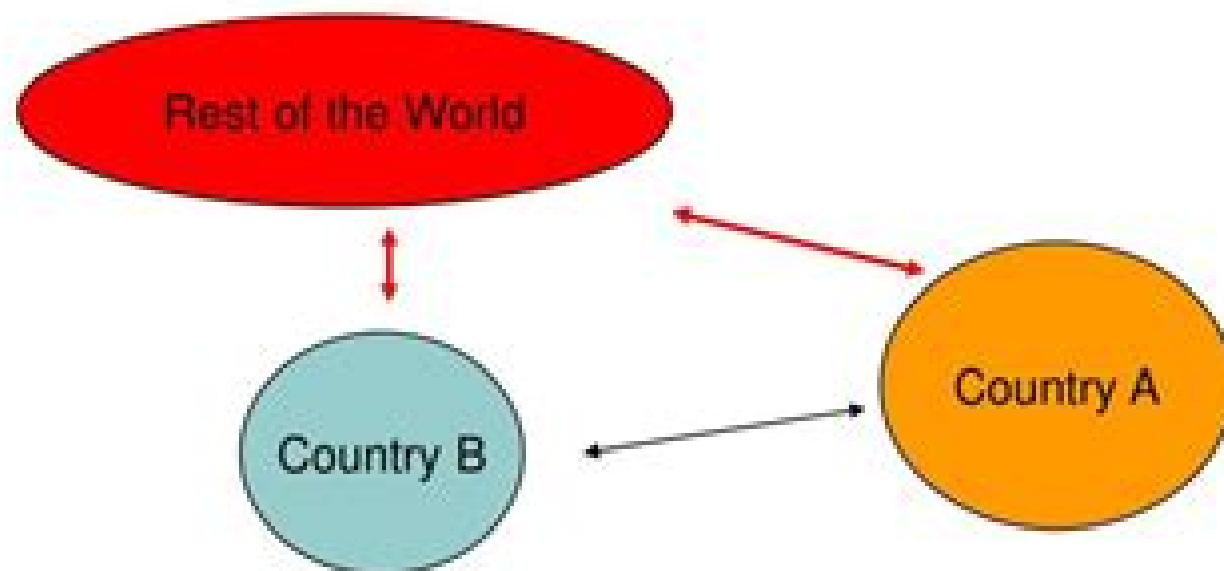

Benedictis, 2014 Since Jan Tinbergen's original formulation Tinbergen 1962 the empirical analysis of bilateral trade flows through the estimation of a gravity equation has gone a long way It has acquired a solid reputation of good fitting it gained respected micro foundations that allowed it to move to a mature stage in which the turn over gravity equation has been replaced by a gravity model and it has dominated the literature on trade policy evaluation In this chapter we show how some of the issues raised by Tinbergen have been the step stones of a 50 year long research agenda and how the numerous empirical and theoretical contributions that followed dealt with old problems and highlighted new ones Some future promising research issues are finally indicated **The Gravity Equation in International Trade** Thomas Chaney, Centre

for Economic Policy Research (Great Britain), National Bureau of Economic Research, 2013 The gravity equation in international trade is one of the most robust empirical findings in economics bilateral trade between two countries is proportional to size measured by GDP and inversely proportional to the geographic distance between them While the role of size is well understood the role of distance remains a mystery I propose the first explanation for the gravity equation in international trade based on the emergence of a stable network of input output linkages between firms Over time a firm acquires more suppliers and customers which tend to be further away I show that if as observed empirically i the distribution of firm sizes is well approximated by Zipf's law and ii larger firms export over longer distances on average then aggregate trade is inversely proportional to distance Data on firm level sectoral and aggregate trade support further predictions of the model **The Gravity Model for International Trade** Tamas Krisztin, Manfred M. along with pseudo ML methods has become a popular way to model international trade flows This approach has several econometric advantages that we outline in the paper We argue that estimating the parameters by ML would only be justified statistically if the trade flows were independent Such an assumption however is generally not valid and a failure to account for spatial dependence may lead to biased parameter estimates and misleading inferences To overcome this estimation

problem we suggest eigenvector spatial filtering variants of the Poisson gravity model without and with zero inflation along with pseudo ML estimation
