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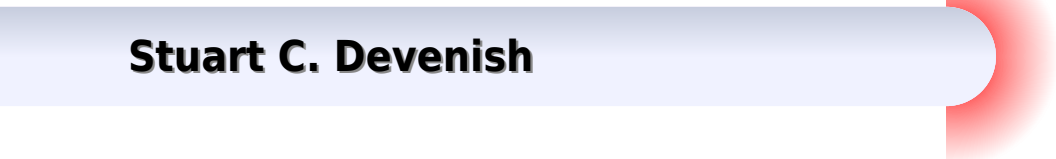

Edmond Hiebert, 2002-09-30 Volume One The Gospels and Acts With typical thoroughness Dr Hiebert has produced this volume of his New Testament introductions Though not a commentary on the gospels and Acts the book presents their message along with a discussion of such questions as authorship composition and the Synoptic problem Practical suggestions on how to study these five books are included The bibliographies and annotated book lists are extremely helpful for pastors teachers and laymen Volume Two The Pauline Epistles This is a detailed introduction to all of Paul's writings epistles that without question are among the most precious treasures of the Christian church Dr Hiebert discusses the historical circumstances of their writing deals with ethical problems and provides helpful general information on the content and nature of the books themselves Discussed in general and separately these epistles are treated in chronological order with emphasis on their eschatology soteriology Christology or ecclesiology

Gnomon of the New Testament, Volume 2 John A. Bengel, 2016-03-01 Bengel's work on the New Testament is a valuable resource for modern students of the Scriptures In 1734 he published a carefully prepared Greek text of the New Testament with an Apparatus criticus which formed the point of departure for modern New Testament textual criticism His famous canon was The more difficult reading is to be preferred This critical work was followed by an exegetical one *Gnomon Novi Testamenti* Tübingen 1742 As a brief and suggestive commentary on the New Testament the *Gnomon* is still of considerable use today Bengel's chief principle of interpretation briefly stated is to read nothing into the Scriptures but to draw everything from them and suffer nothing to remain hidden that is really in them His *Gnomon* exerted considerable influence on exegesis in Germany and John Wesley translated most of its notes and incorporated them into his *Annotatory Notes upon the New Testament* London 1755 A Hauck Schaff Herzog Encyclopedia of Religious Knowledge This volume is 2 of a 5 volume set Each volume is sold separately *Agape in the New Testament, Volume 2* Ceslas Spicq, 2006-09-01 In this insightful work the author explores the fundamental Christian virtue of agape Spicq's genius is the way he combines fine linguistic analysis exegesis and theological insight The three volumes cover most of the New Testament books Volume 1 Agape in the Synoptic Gospels Volume 2 Agape in the Epistles of St Paul the Acts of the Apostles the Epistles of St James St Peter and St Jude Volume 3 Agape in the Gospel Epistles and Apocalypse of St John The word agape in particular had acquired so specialized and rich a meaning that it seemed almost a neologism The final word of the mystery of God and the source of the Christian life is always love Everything is summed up in love from the Introduction **The New Cambridge History of the Bible:**
