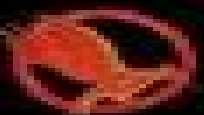
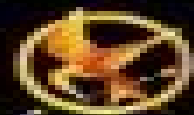
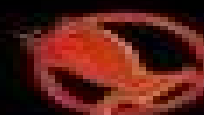
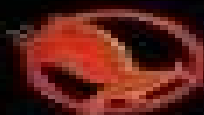
ASSIGNMENT GUIDELINES

BIG PICTURE

Show a deep understanding of an important theme contained in *The Hunger Games* or of how the author used a particular recurring symbol to express important ideas within the story.

STEP-BY-STEP

1. Write a five-paragraph essay analyzing one important theme or symbol in *The Hunger Games*.
2. Start with an introduction paragraph that introduces the book and the major theme or symbol and ends with a clear one-sentence thesis statement while grabbing the reader's attention and interest.
3. Use several specific examples and at least one direct quotation from the book in each of the three body paragraphs as evidence to help prove the point you're trying to make about the theme or symbol.
4. Close with a conclusion paragraph that reviews the thesis and the main ideas of the essay and leaves the reader with a few final interesting and thought-provoking ideas.
5. Follow grammar rules, especially use of commas, correct and varied sentence structure, and correct punctuation of direct quotations.
