circumstances its graduate student authors encountered and solved It does not give its readers long lists of statistics about graduation rates or most advantageous actions for best outcomes What it does instead is provide readers with a vivid sense of the types of life experiences one can expect to encounter when undertaking a graduate degree and the opportunity to discuss these real life issues with others The book was started and developed as a project under the Midwest Crossroads Alliance for Graduate Education and the Professoriate AGEF and completed as part of the professional development activities under the Committee on Institutional Cooperation CIC AGEF
